ABSOLUTE FIT "LEASH HARNESS"

<u>COLLAR</u>: Check to make sure that your collar is sturdy and in good condition. Attach the collar to your dog, verifying that <u>NO MORE THAN ONE FINGER</u> can be slipped between the underside of the collar and the dog's coat. Your dog will be able to back out of the collar if not snug.



STEP1: Attach the leash to the collar and lay the leash along the dog's spine



STEP 3: Pass the leash under the dog's belly just *behind* the front legs.



STEP 2: Hold the leash on the spine right over the shoulders and drape the balance of the leash to the dog's right side.



STEP 4: Put the loop end of the leash <u>under</u> the portion of the leash coming up from <u>the collar and snug</u> it up firmly. NOW the dog can not back out of the collar.
